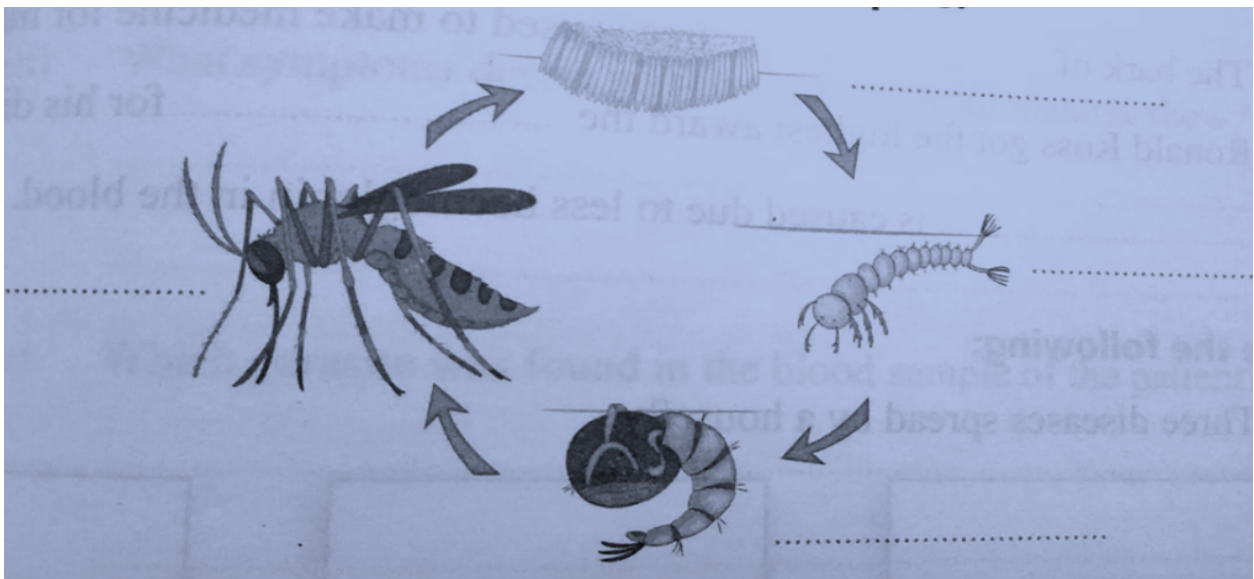

LIFE CYCLE OF A MOSQUITO

Blood-sucking insects such as mosquitoes and fleas can spread various diseases like malaria, dengue. When a female Anopheles mosquito bites a sick person suffering from **malaria**, it sucks the malarial germs along with the blood of sick person. When it bites a healthy person, the malarial germs pass into the victim's blood and make him/her sick. Similarly, Aedes mosquitoes spread **dengue**.
