### I. Learn the given definitions below.

- **Prime number:-** The number which have only two factors ( 1 and itself ) is known as Prime number.
- **Composite number:-** The number which have more than two factors is known as composite number.

### II. Write numbers from 1 to 100 in a 10 x10 grid(10 rows and 10 columns).

**Follow the given instructions to find out prime numbers and composite numbers.**

- Put a box for the number 1 as it has only one factor.
- Encircle 2, and cross out all the multiples of 2, other than 2 itself.
- You will find that next uncrossed number is 3. Encircle 3, and cross out all the multiples of 3, other than 3 itself.
- Next uncrossed number is 5. Encircle 5, cross out all the multiples of 5, other than 5 itself.
- Encircle the next uncrossed number 7, cross out all the multiples of 7, other than 7 itself.
- Now, encircle all the uncrossed numbers. You will find out all the numbers other than 1 are either circled or crossed.
  - All the encircled numbers are prime numbers.
  - All the crossed numbers are composite numbers.
  - 1 is neither prime number nor composite number.
  - This method is called the “**sieve of Eratosthenes**”.

Count and write all the prime numbers (encircled) between 1 and 100.
