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TESTS FOR DIVISIBILITY OF NUMBERS

➤ **Learn the given divisibility rule.**

- **Divisibility by 3:** - If the sum of digits of a number is a multiple of 3, then the number is divisible by 3.

Example:1) 1896

Sum of the digits of 1896 = $1 + 8 + 9 + 6 = 24$

The sum 24 is a multiple of 3.

So, 1896 is divisible by 3.

(by doing actual division you will get a remainder as 0)

Example:2) 1567

Sum of the digits of 1567 = $1 + 5 + 6 + 7 = 19$

The sum 19 is not a multiple of 3.

So, 1567 is not divisible by 3.

(by doing actual division you will get a remainder, other than 0)

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BODY MOVEMENTS

Ball and socket joint: The rounded end of one bone fits into the cavity of other bone. Such a joint allows the movement in all directions.

Hinge joint: The joints are formed between two or more bones where the bones can move along one direction.

Pivotal joint: The joint where our neck joins the head. it allows us to bend our head forward and backward and turn the head to our right and left.

Fixed joints: The fixed joints are the places where two bones come together in the body but are unable to move.

Muscle: A band or bundles of fibrous tissue in human that has ability to contract, producing movement in maintaining position of parts of the body.
