DIALOGUE WRITING

A dialogue is a conversation between two or more people. It is a literary technique in which writers employ two or more characters to be engaged in conversation with each other. It forms the basis for any literary work and makes it enjoyable and lively.

A dialogue enables exchange of ideas or opinions and empowers the speaker and the listener. It facilitates in resolution of issues and breaks the ice between unfamiliar people. It allows for a powerful expression of feelings and adds humour to our lives. While writing a dialogue one must always use appropriate language and short and simple sentences. There must be continuity in the ideas of the dialogue and right punctuations should be used to express the mood and tone of the dialogue. Also, a dialogue should suit the character of the speaker.

Example:

Apology for losing friend's book:

Rekha : Hi, Kalpana. Such a nice weather today!

Kalpana : Hi, Rekha.

Rekha : what's the matter? You seem rather dull.

Kalpana : Rekha, I don't know how to tell you this.... I lost your Physics notes.

Rekha : Lost the notes? How did it happen? You mean you misplaced the book?

Kalpana : No, Rekha. I think I left it by mistake in the bus yesterday. I'm so sorry.

Rekha : I had prepared the notes with so much care, Kalpana.

Kalpana : I know, Rekha. Please excuse me. I know you must be so angry.

Rekha : Not angry, but upset. How will I ever write all those notes again?

Kalpana : I'll help you. I'll complete the work in a week. I promise.

Rekha : Well, don't feel bad. Mistakes happen.

Kalpana : Sorry again, Rekha. I'll buy a notebook right now and begin the work.

समास

समास का तात्पर्य है "संक्षिप्तीकरण"

दो या दो से अधिक शब्दों से मिलकर बने हुए एक नवीन एवं सार्थक शब्द को समास (Samas) कहते हैं।

उदाहरण :

रसोईघर - रसोई के लिए घर।; नीलगाय - नीले रंग की गाय।

समास के नियमों से निर्मित शब्द सामासिक शब्द (Samasik Shabd) कहलाता है। इसे हम समस्त पद (Samast Pad) भी कहते हैं।

अव्ययीभाव समास

इस समास में पहला पद (पूर्व पद) प्रधान होता है और पूरा पद अव्यय होता है

इसमें पहला पद उपसर्ग होता है जैसे अ, आ, अनु, प्रति, हर, भर, नि, निर, यथा, यावत् आदि उपसर्ग शब्द का बोध होता है

नोट : अव्ययीभाव समास में उपसर्ग होता है

उदाहरण:

Aajanm (आजन्म) - जन्म पर्यन्त, **Yathavadhi** (यथावधि) - अवधि के अनुसार

Yathakram (यथाक्रम) - क्रम के अनुसार,

Bekasur (बेकसूर) - **Nidar** (निडर) -

तत्पुरुष समास

इस समास में दूसरा पद (उत्तर पद / अंतिम पद) प्रधान होता है इसमें कर्ता और संबोधन कारक को छोड़कर शेष छः कारक चिन्हों का प्रयोग होता है

जैसे - कर्म कारक, करण कारक, सम्प्रदान कारक, अपादान कारक, सम्बन्ध कारक, अधिकरण कारक

नोट : तत्पुरुष समास में कारक चिन्हों का प्रयोग होता है

उदाहरण :

Vidyalaya (विद्यालय) - विद्या के लिए आलय, **Rajputra** (राजपुत्र) - राजा का पुत्र

Munhtod (मुंहतोड़) - मुंह को तोड़ने वाला, **Chidimar** (चिड़ीमार) - चिड़िया को मारने वाला

Janmandh (जन्मांध) - जन्म से अंधा

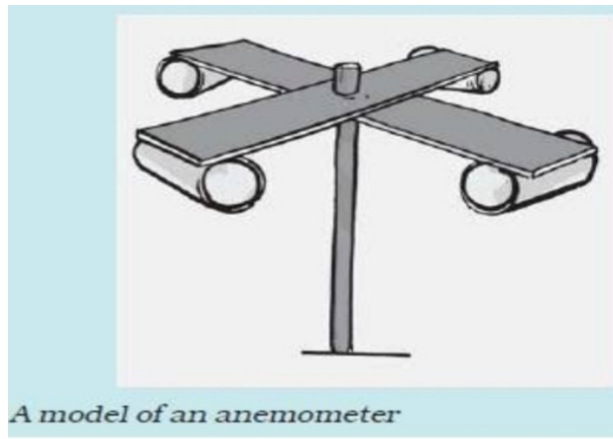
- ❖ Wind speed plays an important role in the formation of Storms. It is therefore important to measure the wind speed. The instrument that measures the wind speed is called an anemometer.
