1. **Address:** The address of the sender is followed by that of the receiver.
2. **Date:** The date is written below the address after leaving one line.
3. **Salutation** / Greeting (Dear / Hi / Hello)
4. **Body:** The matter of the letter is written here. It is divided into 3 paragraphs as follows -
 - a) **Paragraph 1:** beginning
 - b) **Paragraph 2:** Main content.
 - c) **Paragraph 3:** ending
5. Sender's name and signature.

It is a volume of rules and regulations which determine the nature of the state and the system of government that implements its policies to achieve the basic aims and objectives of the state and its duties. Elections to the constituent assembly were held in July 1946, and met for the first time on 9th December 1946, and elected Dr. Rajendra Prasad as its chairman. The drafting committee was constituted on 29th August 1947, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar was elected as its chairman. At last the revised constitution was approved on 26th November 1949. Our constitution came into force on 26th January 1950. We celebrate this day every year as Republic day.
